MINUTES OF THE SCHOOL PARENTS MEETING 27 June 2007 at 20.00

Mrs Zanatta was chairing the meeting and made the following announcements for 2007-08:

- Starting in September, the school will be an official Associated European School. Studies at the Scuola per l'Europa di Parma are now officially recognized up to the 5th grade of secondary level. A working group has been commissioned by the "Conseil Superieur" in Brussels and should meet on the 2nd of July to propose a transition plan for the 6th and 7th year of secondary and the baccalaureat until they are officially recognized in Parma.
- The experimental phase of the Scuola per l'Europa is over on the 31st of August. Starting in September, the school will have a different juridical status within the Italian school system and will be considered as an independant school. This will allow a more transparent administration and will make it easier to follow the rules of the European school system.
- The call for vacancies for new teachers should be out this afternoon 28 June 2007. Please advertise the positions within your network as much as possible. Call ends on the 21st of July with interviews planned for the last week of July.
- The Comune is going to work on the necessary security enhancements to the building over the summer.

On the site, Mrs Zanatta showed us the information already available: timetables for materna, primary and secondary, calendar, total number of pupils in 2007-08 (443 today), classes, list of books and materials needed in 2007-08, school fees.
- Changes in the secondary timetable include less guided study time and 2 free afternoons: Tuesday and Friday with the possibility for extracurricular activities.
- School fees in 2007-08 will be 500/year or 50/month for 10 months with 50% discount for 2nd child and 75% discount for more children. Fees for the canteen do not change.
- All curriculum information can be found on the European school site www.eurisc.org
- Library and Computer room should both be fully operational in 2007-08
- Extracurricular activities will not be covered by the school fees in 2007-08 and parents will have to pay for the extra cost.
Cost will be based on the number of activities chosen by the parents as well as the nature of the activity. Childminding time will also be offered during free time at a cost. Parma Operart has won the call and will manage all extracurricular activities and garderie activities until 18.00 in 2007-08.

A working group has been put in place by the school with representatives of the school, the parents and ParmaOperart to ensure a good administration of this newly outsourced service.

Mrs Eddy Lovaglio, president of Parma Operart, made the following announcements:

- All information on activities and fees will be on the school web site next week.
- Registration forms should be filled out by the 30th of July for activities to be able to start on the 4th of September.
